Boulder Camping Ban Ordinance

5-6-10. - Camping or Lodging on Property Without Consent.

(a)

- No person shall camp
- within any park, parkway, recreation area, open space, or other city property. ***

Boulder Camping Ban Ordinance

- (b)
- No person shall camp within any public property other than city property or any private property without first having obtained:
 - (1)
 - Permission of the authorized officer of such public property; or
 - (2)
 - Permission of the owner of private property.

Boulder Camping Ban Ordinance

- (d)
- For purposes of this section, camp means
- to reside or dwell temporarily in a place,
- with shelter,

Boulder Camping Ban Ordinance

and

- conduct activities of daily living,
- such as eating or sleeping, in such place.
- But the term *does not include*
- napping during the day
- or picnicking.

Boulder Camping Ban Ordinance

- The term *shelter* includes,
- without limitation,

ANY COVER

or protection from the elements

OTHER THAN CLOTHING.
